DESCRIPTION OF ROLE

VOLUNTEER

- **To be accountable to the Family Group Co-ordinator & Home Start Management Committee.**
- **To assist in the play activities and organisation of the Family Group.**

This includes:-

- Assist in the organisation and preparation of play activities.
- Assist with preparing the room prior to families' arrival (if possible) and assist with the clearing up & putting equipment away at the end of the session.
- Encouragement of children to participate in craft or other activity and support for children to encourage positive play.
- Encouragement of parental supervision of children and social interaction with other parents.
- Assist in the preparation of the mid morning snack/ drinks for parents & children, if required.
- At all times work within the Family Group Guidelines and equal opportunities framework.

Skills Required:-

- An understanding of good child care practices
- Ability to communicate at all levels
- Ability to work within a team
- Ability to assist in meeting the needs of young children & their parents
- A commitment to Equal Opportunities
- Be available 9-12 on Tuesdays in term time

Experience of interacting with children within the 0 – 3 years age will be a great advantage.
