## UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Children should wear grey trousers, tailored shorts, skirts/ skorts or pinafore dresses.

Children should wear a gold polo shirt which can be with or without the school logo.

Socks should be grey or black only (no trainer socks).

In the summer, a green checked dress can be worn with white socks.



Children must wear black school shoes with no heel. Sandals and boots are not allowed. Any shoes worn must be completely black with no white showing.

## HAIR

Hair bows and headbands can only be worn in the school colour of green. Hijabs may be emerald green, grey or black.

Children wearing hair accessories of a different colour will be asked to remove them.

Children should not have extreme haircuts, e.g. tram lines, and parents will be spoken to if their child comes in with an unacceptable hair style.

## PE REQUIREMENTS

Children are to wear black sports shorts.

They may choose to wear black tracksuit bottoms and a black sweatshirt or zipped hoodie but these are to be free of any sports logo and should be completely plain.

Children should wear a green PE t-shirt with the school logo and these can be purchased from Valentino Schoolwear.



Children need to wear plimsolls or trainers for PE. These types of trainers are suitable **ONLY** for PE but **CANNOT** be worn with school uniform:



## ACCESSORIES

Children may wear a wristwatch but smart watches are not permitted and children will be asked to remove these and they will be given to parents at the end of the day.

Nail polish is not allowed and parents will be asked to remove this for the following day.

Earrings should only be small studs and children must be able to remove these themselves to take part in PE.

Headbands should be simple and only in school colours.

## INCORRECT UNIFORM PROCEDURE

At Brookwood, we have high expectations of children and expect them to wear their Brookwood uniform with pride, to represent our school. Any child who is not wearing the correct uniform will be supplied with uniform on loan from the school for that day. If they refuse to wear the uniform provided, they will miss a part of their playtime.

If your child has a particular reason, e.g. medical, why they are unable to wear correct school uniform, please speak to a member of SLT. Children will need to wear correct uniform in secondary school so we want to instil good habits early on.
