We would like to remind you of our procedure in the event that your child is absent from school. Mon 30 July - Fri 03 Aug

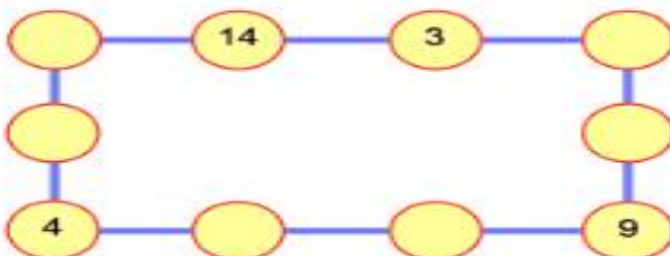
