Data Collection Sheets

Every year, we ask all our families to review the information that we hold about the children in order to either confirm that it is still up to date, or to advise us of any changes. Due to the new data protection laws, we are changing the way in which we send this information home to you, and will prepare the information in named envelopes to be distributed as follows:

If you have a child in Squirrels, Ladybirds or Bumblebees classes, the class teaching team will give you a named envelope on Monday 17th September when you collect your child. If you have a child in Hedgehogs, Badgers or Owls classes and are collecting your child at the end of the day, we would be grateful if you could come into the office to collect your named envelope.

If someone else usually collects your child, please let us know via email (admin@brookwood.surrey.sch.uk) if you would like to nominate them to collect the information on your behalf. We will only issue the information if we have an email from you confirming that you are content for the nominated person to collect it. Please note that we will not accept responsibility for missing envelopes once they have been handed to you or collected on your behalf.

We would be grateful if you could review the information we hold to check it is still up to date, and please could you also ensure that we have full details for two emergency contacts for your child as this is now a statutory requirement. Please return the information to the school office at your earliest convenience with any changes clearly marked, or signed to confirm that the details remain correct, so that we can ensure our records are up to date.
