Who are ACT?

Assessment Consultation Therapy (ACT) is a service within Surrey that works with children and adolescents who display with sexualised behaviour. We work therapeutically supporting parents, carers and families.

Why Should I Attend the Group?

- ◆ Sometimes we all need someone to talk to
- ◆ The opportunity to share problems and gain advice and support
- ◆ Chat, offer each other support and socialise without being judged, as well as learn new things, have discussions, and get advice
- ◆ To feel like a normal family where you and your children are not judged
- ◆ The opportunity to make friends and socialise with others
- ◆ To develop a support network
- ◆ Take some time out for yourself

What Should I Expect?

- A relaxed and non-judgemental environment to meet and chat with others
- A safe and confidential environment
- The opportunity to meet others with shared experiences
- ACT staff to support and provide advice
- Refreshments will be provided
- A chance to share any concerns or thoughts
